<b>MONEY</b>	Talk about the people who taught you how to save money and handle money.	Let the children help you plan your weekly menu. Use this time to discuss wise spending and finding value.	Talk about the importance of tithing. Make a game out of determining one tenth of various amounts of money.
<b>TIME &amp; TALENT</b>	Make a list of the talents and gifts represented in your family. How are you using these for God?	Take fresh spring flowers to a nursing home and spend time talking to residents.	Collect old sports equipment (gloves, balls, etc.) and donate to kids who might need them.
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b>	Plant a tree in your yard.	Make a birdhouse and place it in your yard.	Clean up a local park.

<b>MONEY</b>	Have a family yard sale and give the proceeds to a local ministry or a church project.	Use "back-to-school" shopping as an opportunity to discuss the difference between "want" and "need."	Talk about the importance of giving to various church offerings.
<b>TIME &amp; TALENT</b>	Volunteer to help in a local rescue mission or homeless shelter.	Take bottles of water to people who work outdoors during the summer.	Collect books in good condition and donate them to a local daycare center.
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b>	Mow the lawn and care for plants of neighbors who are away on vacation.	Collect aluminum cans and recycle them – donating the money to charity.	Volunteer to clean up trash at a community event or fair.

<b>MONEY</b>	Talk about the importance of saving. Make individual savings containers.	Make the Thanksgiving offering a family project. Use this as a time to discuss how God has blessed your family.	Put the focus on giving Christmas gifts.
<b>TIME &amp; TALENT</b>	Rake leaves for an elderly homeowner.	Take food baskets to need families.	Plan a special Christmas project as a family.
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b>	Help winterize homes of the elderly.	Collect old phone books in your neighborhood for recycling.	Volunteer to conduct an energy audit for your church.
