Churches submit Point-to-Point requests when gifts don't go through Nazarene Global Treasury Services. This step-by-step guide will help you receive Ten Percent Goal acknowledgement for giving to Mission Projects such as Work & Witness trip expenses or US Compassionate Ministry Centers. - 1 Open a browser and go to fundingthemission.org. Click "Login" at the top right. Follow the prompts to enter your login information.

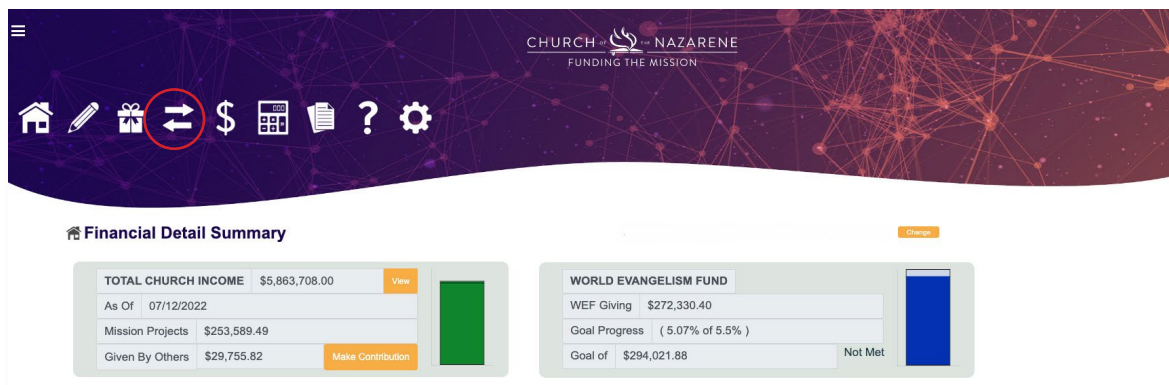

- 2 You should now see the dashboard for your church. Click the arrows icon to go to the Point-to-Point page.



- 3 A form will load at the top of the Point-to-Point page. Fill out the form, including the gift category, intent of the gift, and amount of the gift. If your church is reporting giving to a US Compassionate Ministry Center or a District Project, use the search menu to find the CMC or the approved project by name.

If you will be reporting the amount of your gift as a part of your church's total income, check the "Reported as Income" box. If not, do not check the box. Usually, the box is left unchecked when an individual in your church has given directly to an approved Nazarene project and you are reporting for that individual donor.

Click "Save" to complete your request.

Point-to-Point Giving (2022-2023) [Change](#)

A Point-to-Point request is a way for your church to tell the General Treasurer that your church gave money directly to a Nazarene Approved Mission Project in the US that has been designated as a Ten Percent Project without sending the money through the General Treasurer's office first. Reporting gifts that you gave directly to an approved mission project (such as a US Nazarene Compassionate Ministry Center or a New Start Church plant on your district) is beneficial because that gift will help your church reach the Mission Ten giving goal.

- 4 You will see the request saved at the bottom on the page. Initial status will say "pending" until it has been approved or declined.

- 5 Once the request has been approved or declined, you will receive an email from the Stewardship Development team. If approved, the amount of the gift is added to your church's mission project gift total on the home page.
